# How to install document fonts

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Search in the main folder for a file named 'fonts'.pdf.
2. Open the file and hit the buttons to open the fonts in a new browser window.
2. Download the font files and open the downloaded folder.
3. Select and right-click all .ttf and .otf files and hit open.
4. A window pops up asking you to install the fonts.
5. Finally click 'Install' and the fonts are ready to use.

# How to scroll through layers

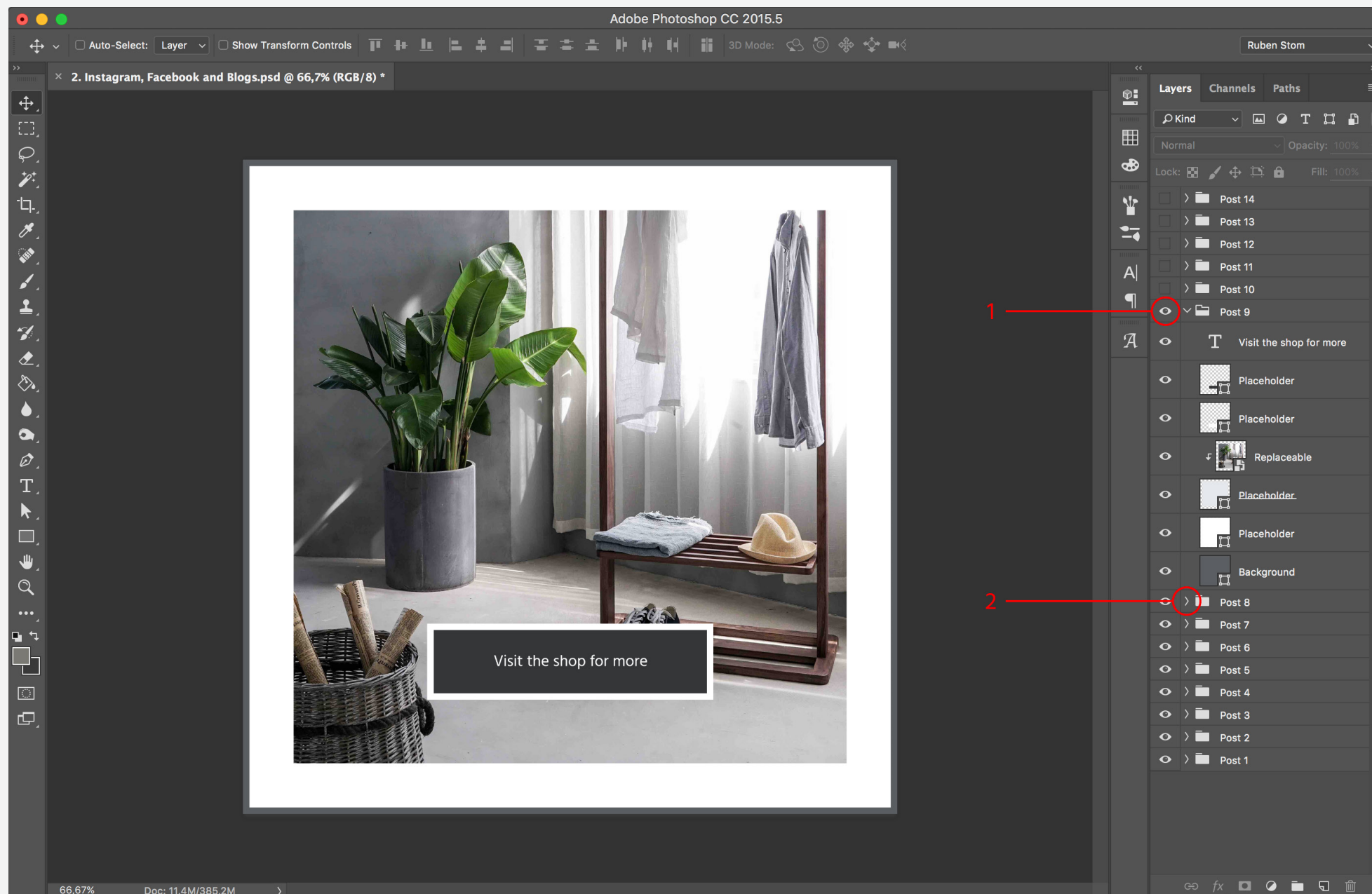
### INSTRUCTIONS

1. Once you've opened your templates in Photoshop you see one template. If you want to scroll through the other templates you can do so by hitting the eye-icon in front of each grouped layer (named: Post 1, Post 2 etc.).
2. To view and adjust each layer within a grouped layer you can click the arrow in front of the 'folder icon' in your layer panel. The grouped layer unfolds and you should see all individual layers.

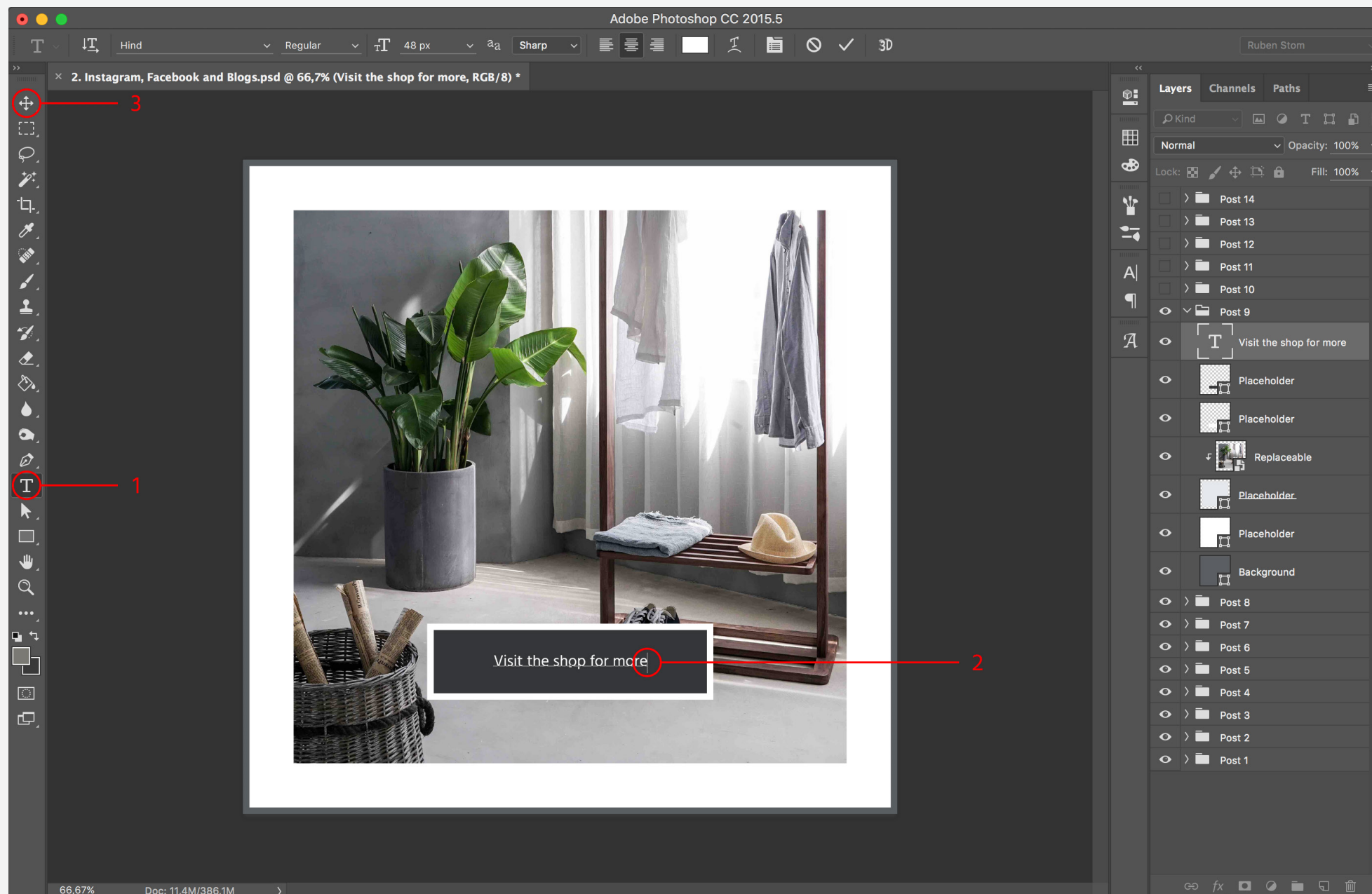

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. To replace any given placeholder text with your own, you have to select the 'Text Tool' in the tool panel.
2. Select the placeholder text you'd like to replace. Now you can type your own text.
3. Select the 'Move Tool' in the tool panel to confirm your adjustments.

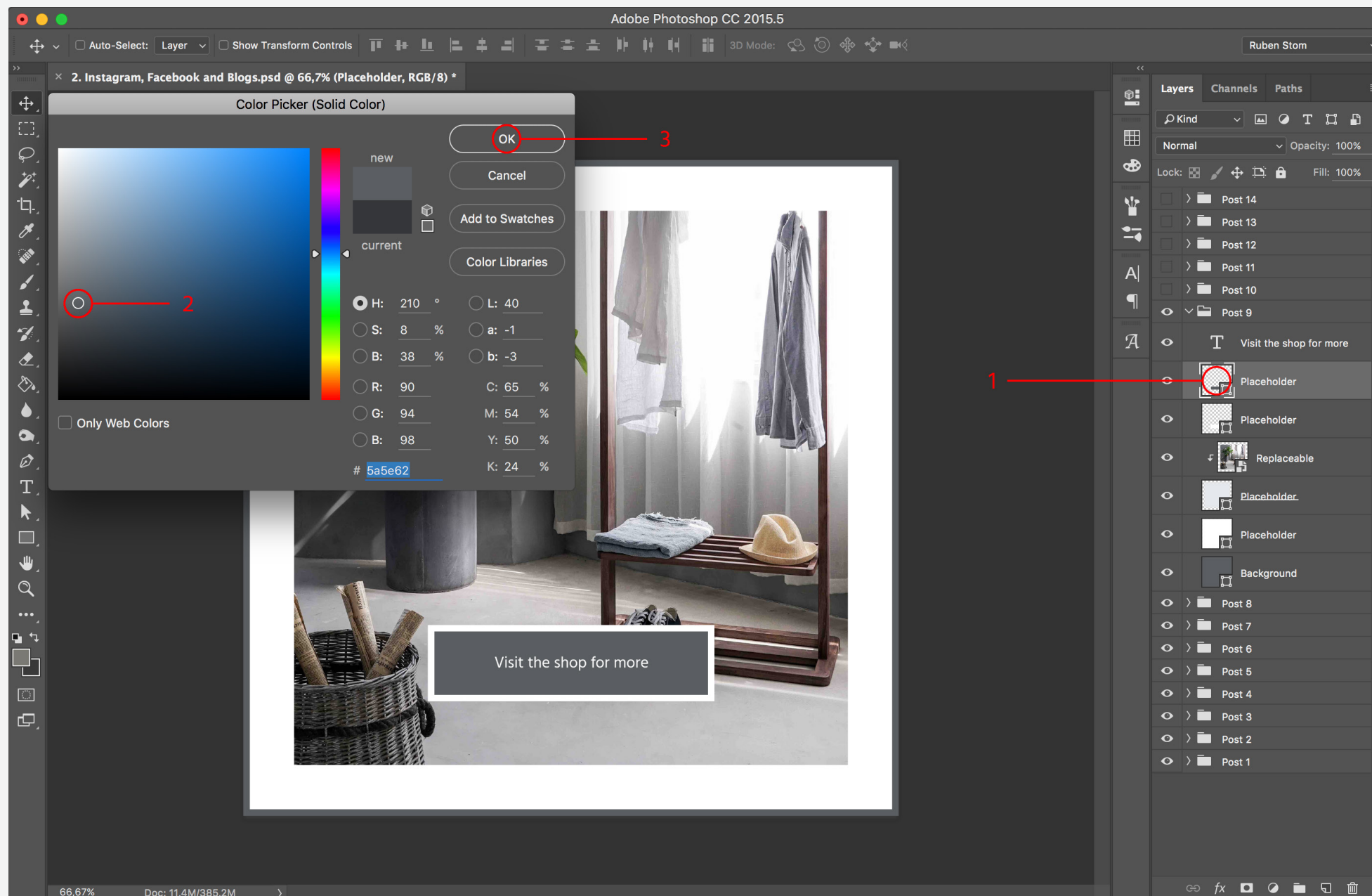
## INSTRUCTIONS

1. To adjust the colors provided select the layer you'd like to change and then double click the colored thumbnail (make sure not to click on the layer name, but on the thumbnail) in front of the layer.
2. A new window opens with a color picker. You can now change the color.
3. Hit 'OK' to confirm your adjustments.

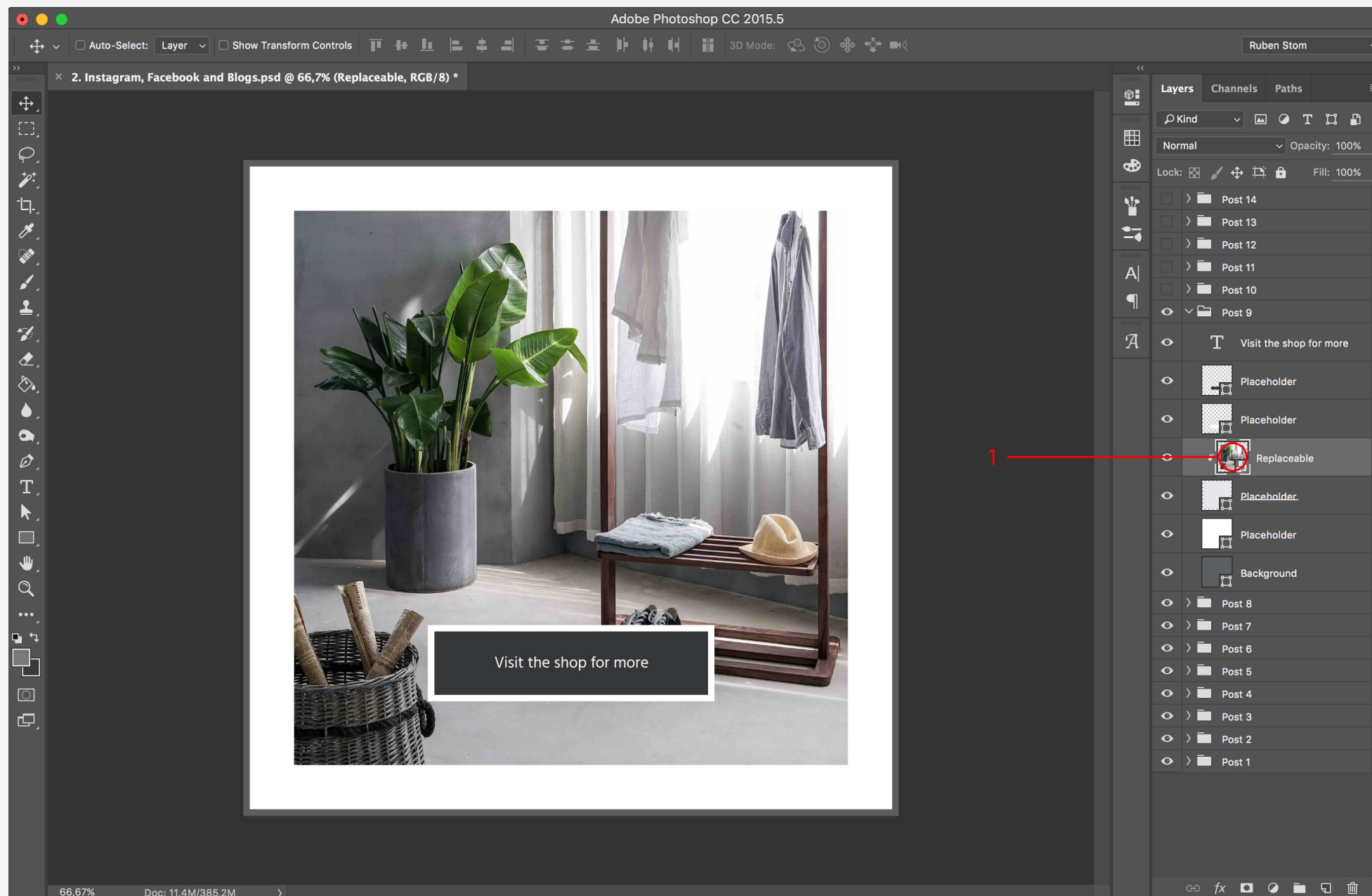

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. To replace the images select the layer you'd like to change (named: Replaceable) and then double click the thumbnail (make sure not to click on the layer name, but on the thumbnail) in front of the layer.
2. A new window pops up. Drop the image of your choice in the newly opened window.
3. Save and close that window. Your image will automatically have replaced the original.
