

# Grey Typography

## Photoshop Action

Thank you for purchasing this item. Grey Typography is a Photoshop action that will transform your image producing multiple organized layers with smart filters, blend options and layer masks in order to provide rich customization possibilities.

In order to use the action, you will have to load the Grey Typography Action Photoshop. Follow [this](#) tutorial if you don't know how to install an action.

The action uses the [Calibri](#) font.

### Setting up the image for the action:

1. Open an image into Photoshop. Make sure the image is in RGB mode, 8bits (Go to *Image menu - Mode* to check). Your image will have a Background layer (Visible in the Layers panel). Recommended image size is 3000x4500px.
2. Select the layer you want to be transformed – could be the Background layer or any other layer (can have transparency).
3. Run the action by selecting Grey Typography Action from the Actions panel and clicking Play.

The action will prompt you to adjust 3 text layers that it creates – they come at a default size of 3000x4500px. If your image size is different, adjust the size of each text layer when prompted; otherwise, just confirm the text. You can adjust the text font and content while prompted by the action or later.

### Customization

To replace the texts/fonts, edit any of the smart layers named Small text, Medium Text or Large text. Each also have their colors adjustable. There are also masks you can brush to reveal the original color of the image and to reveal some other colors.
