LIGHTROOM DESKTOP

GETTING STARTED


To begin working with Lightroom Presets, you'd first need to start Adobe Lightroom on your PC or Mac. Make sure the .zip file you've downloaded is unarchived and the Lightroom Preset files are stored at a convenient location.

INSTALLING LR PRESETS

Then, in Adobe Lightroom, go to **Edit • Preferences • Presets**. Click on the box entitled **Show Lightroom Presets Folder**. In the window that opens up, navigate to the folder **Lightroom**, and then to **Develop Presets**.

In the **Develop Presets** folder, create a new folder for your downloaded presets or choose one of the existing.

Copy the downloaded presets to that folder and **restart Adobe Lightroom**. The presets will be available the next time you open Lightroom.



Click on **Preferences --> Presets** to begin importing/installing the presets.

USING LR PRESETS

In Adobe Lightroom, click on the Develop tab to open the develop menu. Once there, you'd see your new presets in the Presets section on the left. Click on any preset to apply it.

ADJUSTING SKIN TONE

If skin tones are just not right (orange, saturated, unnatural), turn down Temperature and Saturation sliders until the colors look better.

TIP! TIP! TIP! Use Saturation Slider to desaturate skin tones or other areas of the photo that seem too rich.

TIP! TIP! TIP! Use White Balance Sliders to change the feel/vibe of the entire picture.

RECOVERING DARK PHOTOS

Try bringing up **Exposure** and **Shadows** sliders. This will brighten up the photo. Hold off **Highlights** and **Whites** sliders if the brighter areas of the photo are too bright.

GIVING SKIN A NATURAL GLOW

In the **HSL (Hue-Saturation-Luminance)** menu, go to the **Luminance** tab and bring up **Reds** and **Oranges** until the skin has a natural glow.

TIP! TIP! TIP! You can save the adjustments you made either by **creating a new preset (+ sign in the Presets section)** or by **updating the existing preset (right click on the preset, then Update with Current Settings)**.


GETTING STARTED

To begin working with **Lightroom Mobile Presets**, you'd first need to download the files from the website you purchased the preset(s) from. Usually, there should be a link to download in your email.

IMPORTING LR MOBILE PRESETS

If Mobile Presets come in a **ZIP archive**, you'd need to unzip it first. If you need help with unzipping, send me a message and I'll gladly send you the unzipped files.


Then you'd need to save the .DNG files onto your device (usually better for Android) or Import them directly into your Lightroom App.



The first option is **Copy to Lightroom CC**.

CREATING LR MOBILE PRESETS

Once the DNG file opens up in Lightroom CC (it's just going to look like a regular image with name of preset and number), **click on Settings** (three dots in top-right corner) and select **Create Preset** option. Feel free to rename the preset or create new folder.



Click on **Create Preset** and save the preset from the DNG image.

ADJUSTING LR MOBILE PRESETS

Kindly refer to the left side of the document: the tweaking is very similar to PC/Mac versions of presets.

TIP! TIP! TIP! Using the same preset for your Instagram feed will make it look more consistent and professional.
