Q : Does extended license come with this purchase?


A : You can check before you buy my template Standard or Extended License do you want to buy.

A : No, I'm NOT selling mockup, but I will send recommended mockup from other Author.




DOWNLOAD AND INSTALL THE FONTS

Whilst the fonts are free to download, we are not allowed to include the fonts in the .zip as they are not ours to distribute.



Included a text file which includes links to the font files. Please ensure that you download and install the font files before opening the file.




LAYER PALLETTE




The layers palette is where you'll find the contents of this document. If the layers palette is not visible, you can find it by going to **Window > Layers** in the menu bar and ensuring Layers is checked.


To make the layers easy to navigate, we've divided them into clearly labelled folders. To expand the group, click the small arrow on the left hand side of the folder. This will display all the enclosed layers.




EDITING TEXT



- First, you must select the type tool in the tool panel (*window > tools*)
- Next, navigate to the text you wish to edit
- Double click the text and highlight the words you wish to edit
- Once finished, press the escape key




EDITING COLOR




If you wish to edit a box, do the following:

- Find the box in the layers palette and double click the small thumbnail next to the layer name.
- This will open the color selector. Choose your color accordingly.
- Click OK




EDITING LINE/STROKES




If you wish to edit a line/stroke, do the following:


- Click on the the stroke layer in the layers palette.
- Open the properties palette (*windows > properties*)
- Click the stroke box (circled red in the above diagram)
- Choose your color from dropdown color selector.



ADDING IMAGES



- Images in this template are saved as smart layers. This saves you from having to resize and scale your images to work within this template.
- To add an image you must first find the image layer named Double Click to add image – Double click this layer. A new empty file will open.
- Place your image in this file by going to **File > Place** and selecting your image.
- Make sure the placed image fills the whole artboard, once your happy go to **File > Save** and close the file.
- Your original file will be updated with the new image.
