Hi,

Thank You for purchasing **3D Parallax Photoshop Actions**.

Please check the following before you play the action:

1. Your photo is the "**Background**" layer. If not, select your photo layer and go to **Layer > New > Background from Layer**.
2. Go to **Image > Mode** and make sure your photo is in the "**RGB Color**", "**8 Bits/Channel**" mode.
3. Your photo is high quality and resolution. For best results use photos that are between **2000 px - 4500 px** high/wide.
4. You are using the **English** version of Photoshop. If you are using another language, you can change the language in this way:

After you play the action, you can change the language back to your native language.

How to load the action:

1. Once you start the Photoshop, go to the "**Window**" menu and select "**Actions**" from there.
2. In the "**Actions**" panel, click on the menu icon in the top right-hand corner, choose "**Load Actions**", select the action that came with download and click "**Load**".
3. The action will now appear in the "**Actions**" panel.

How to use the action:

1. Go to **File > Open**, choose your photo and click "**Open**".
2. Go to **Layer > New > Layer** to create a new layer and name it "**brush**".
3. While the "**brush**" layer is selected, choose the "**Brush Tool (B)**", pick a soft brush and brush over your subject as guided in the action preview image. Or make a selection of your subject using any of the Photoshop selection tools and fill it with a color.

4. Open the **"3D Parallax"** action folder, select the **"Set Up"** action and click on **"Play"** button.

Now select any of the **"Subject Animation"** and **"Background Animation"** actions and click on **"Play"** button to animate subject and background. Make sure to open the **"Timeline"** panel by going to **Window > Timeline** so you can play the animation.

If you have played the **"125% Scale - From Center"** animation action for example, and would like to try some other, simply select other animation action (**"150% Scale - From Top Left"** for example) and click on **"Play"** button. The action will remove the previous animation and create a new one.

If you want to invert the animation, select the **"Invert Subject Animation"** or **"Invert Background Animation"** action and click on **"Play"** button. These actions will invert the animation of the subject/background. If you have played the **"125% Scale - From Center"** action for example, the animation will transform subject/background from original size to 125% scale. After running invert action, the animation will transform subject/background from 125% scale to original size. Invert actions will also invert the direction from which the subject/background is being transformed.

Once you are happy with the animation effect, you can select any of the **"Adjustments"** (**"Color Looks"**, **"Contrast"**, **"Brightness"** and **"Vibrance/Saturation"**) actions and click on **"Play"** button.

To save the animation, select one of the **"Export"** (**"Animation"** or **"Video"**) actions and click on **"Play"** button.

Please watch the video tutorial for demonstration of how to use the action and also how to customize the results to get the most out of the effect.
