

Install the font

Please download and install the list of fonts on the file help.txt


How to Install Fonts in Windows

Once you have your font downloaded, unzip it, and then just right-click it and click Install.



How to Install Fonts in Mac

Under Mac OS X 10.3 or above (including the FontBook) Double-click the font file > "Install font" button at the bottom of the preview.

Open the file

Please make sure you have installed Adobe Photoshop CS2 or later to open the document.

To open the file, just double click on it

Change the text




Click on the "T" icon on the leftside of the screen



Click on the text you want to edit

Select the text, and click delete. Now you are ready to type your text





After you finish edit the text, click on the Arrow icon on the leftside of the screen

You can also move the text using this tools



Change the image

Click on the triangle icon on the leftside of the folder name, it will show you the entire smart object on the document




Double click on the smart object thumbnail



It will open a new blank page. This is the page to place your image.


Place your image there by dragging it directly to the blank page



After you place the photo on the page, don't press anything. Because you have to resize the image to fill the smart object.


Click on the side of the image while holding Shift+Alt (it will keep the aspect ratio of the image) and then start resize the image as you need

And then press Enter



Save the document by pressing Ctrl+S (win) / command+S (mac) or by Select File>Save on the menu.

Now, close the document by pressing the "x" icon on left top side of the page



Now you can see your image on the main page. Do the same method to change the others image
