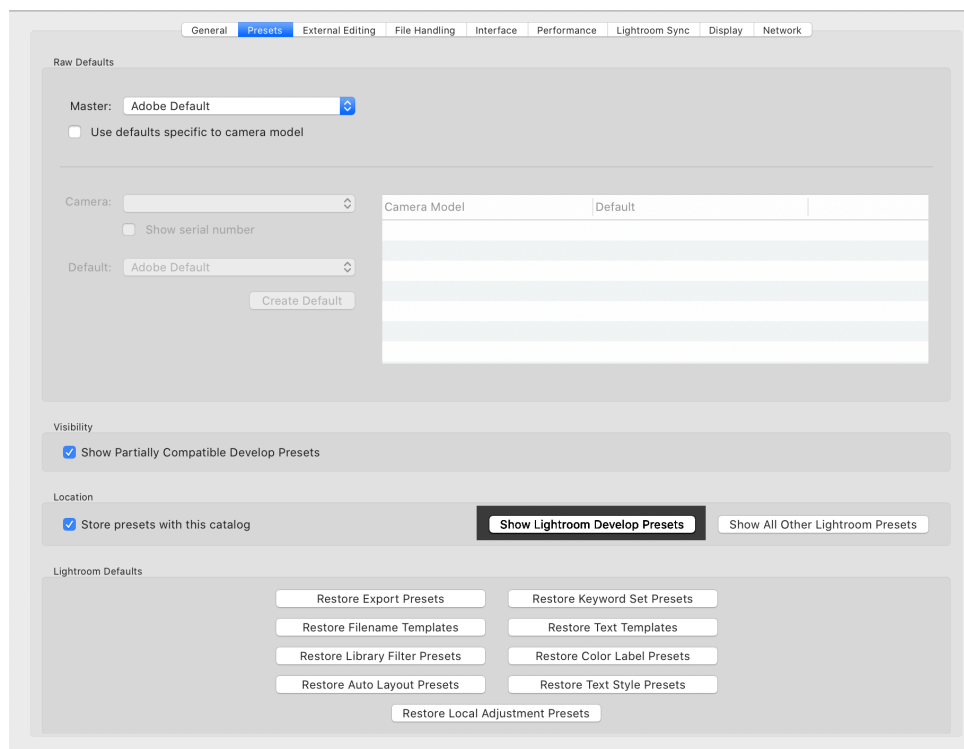
OPEN LIGHTROOM'S PRESETS FOLDER

Installing Lightroom presets is an easy process. All you have to do is copy the new presets into Lightroom's Preset folder.

1.- Open Lightroom.

2.- **On a WIN**, go into Lightroom and click on **Edit** at the top (next to File), then click on Preferences. **On a Mac**, click on the **Lightroom tab** (to the left of File), then click on Preferences.

3.- Click the "Presets" tab.



4.- Click "Lightroom Presets Folder"

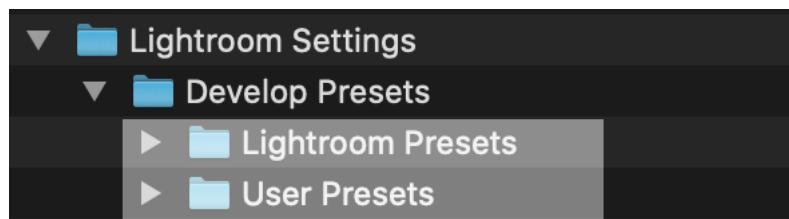


5.- After that, you should see you're a window displaying the Lightroom presets folder on your computer. Double click it.

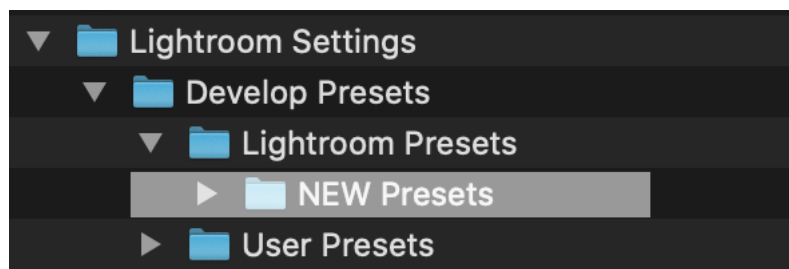
MOVE PRESETS INTO THE FOLDER

Once the Lightroom's Presets folder is open you'll have to move your new presets inside.

1.- On a different window locate your RockShutter Lightroom presets folder.



2.- Open and copy or move the folder inside "Develop Presets" to the one with the same name in the Lightroom's Presets folder.



3.- Repeat step 2 for "Local Adjustment Presets".

Important: Remember that "Develop Presets" go inside the folder with the same name, same thing for "Local Adjustment Presets"

RESTART LIGHTROOM

In order to see and use the new presets you just installed you'll have to restart Lightroom.

1.- Close Lightroom.

2.- Close the Lightroom Presets folder.

3.- Open Lightroom again.

4.- You should be able to see your new presets on the left side panel of your screen under "Presets".



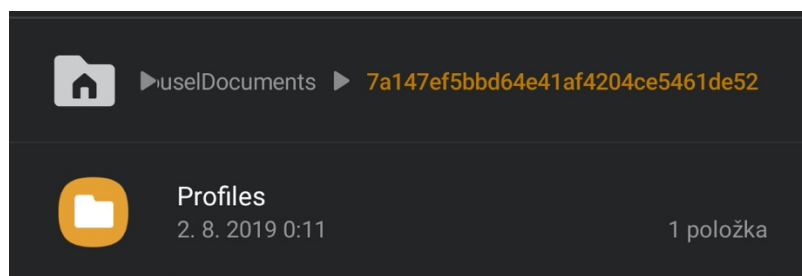
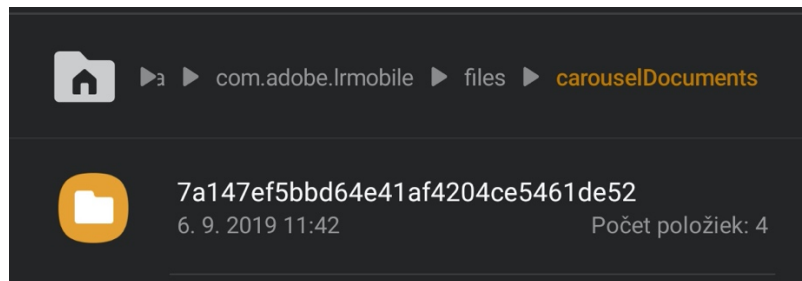
IOS INSTALLATION

1. **Upload Unzipped Folder** with **.dng** files to your Cloud storage (for example Dropbox)
2. **Open** Adobe Photoshop Lightroom for Mobile
3. Click on the (...) **Settings Button** and choose **Add Photos** option
4. Choose the **location** on your phone (for example Dropbox) where you downloaded and unzipped **.dng** files
5. Double click on **.dng** file you would like to work with...
6. **.dng** file will be installed in Lightroom Mobile
7. Choose **.dng** file you have installed before, then click on the (...) **Settings Button** and click on the **Copy Settings**
8. Click on **Select All**, then unselect **Crop** setting and click on **OK** button
9. **Choose** a picture you would like to edit in Mobile Lightroom
10. Click on the (...) **Settings Button** and then click on the **Past Settings**

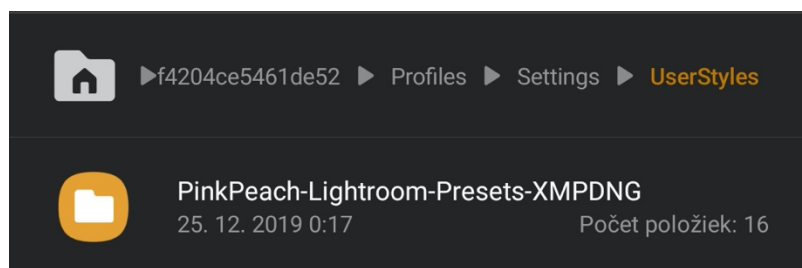


ANDROID INSTALLATION

1. Transfer XMP to your mobile device
2. Go to Android folder folder in internal storage
3. Go to Data
4. Go to com.adobe.lrmobile
5. Go to files
6. Go to carouselDocuments
7. Go to folder named with characters and numbers (photo example)



8. Go to Profiles
9. Go to Settings
10. Go to UserStyles **here** you import folder or file



11. Restart app
