HDR Oil Paint Effect Photoshop Action turns your images into professional **HDR oil paint** in just a few minutes. work on only Photoshop and use on all type of images. This action works in a non-destructive way to achieve a high-quality look. So, the original image layer will remain unchanged. This action has been tested and works on many images and checked on photoshop **CS 6, CC 2015, CC 2015.5, CC 2017, CC 2018, CC 2020 +** version. [Follow me](#) on Graphicriver for latest updates. Save your hours of work with this action. After finish, the action of your work result gets a well-organized and structured file with the many layers, folders, and settings. In this tutorial, I talk about How to use Photoshop Action. If you don't understand then watch Video Tutorials. **Size Recommended:** The action works best with images having size around 2000px – 3000px high/wide and 72/300 dpi resolution. Using lower resolution images will result not clear.

Read Important to know:

1. Make sure you are using the English version of Photoshop to run the Action on.
2. Use high-resolution photos with the Action for the best results and to avoid errors. Size around 2000px – 3000px high/wide and 72/300 dpi resolution.
3. Use Jpeg images to run the Action on.
4. Avoid using the Action on logos or clip art style images as the lack of detail and color contrast can lead to errors.
5. Use the RGB Mode and 8 Bits color. To check these settings, go to Image->Mode and check the “RGB color” and “8 Bits/Channel”.
6. If this action used OIL Paint Filter, then make the oil paint filter enabled.
7. If you have done everything and still getting errors, please reset your preference files. ‘Edit > Preferences > General’ and then selecting ‘Reset Preferences’ then restart photoshop.

How to Set Up Your Document:

1. Load Action file.
2. Just Open your image and change the Height or width between 2000 and 3000px.
3. Then run the action file. There will be two options in the same action file with and without oil paint, respectively. If you want to use oil paint filter, make sure that the oil paint command is enabled.

How to load Action, brush and pattern file.

Load Brush:

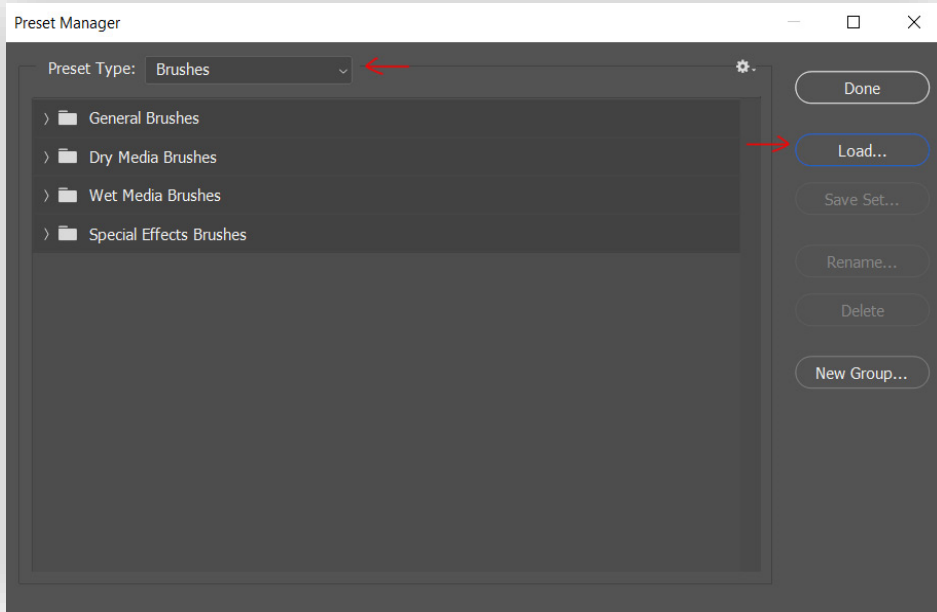
Go to Edit > Presets > Preset Manager... In the Preset Manager window, select Preset Type: Brushes and click Load...

Load Pattern:

Go to Edit > Presets > Preset Manager... In the Preset Manager window, select Preset Type: Pattern and click Load...

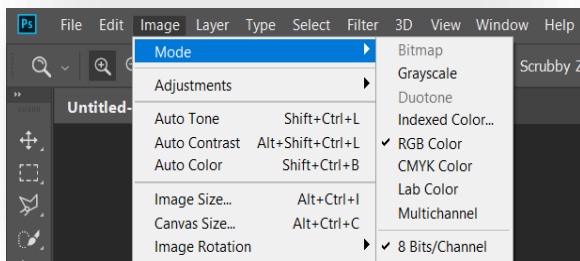
Load Action:

Go to Window>Action(Alt+F9), Click the fly-out list of the Action panel right side to load action.

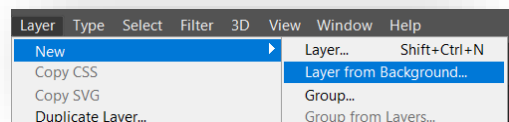


How to configure Photoshop to work with actions:

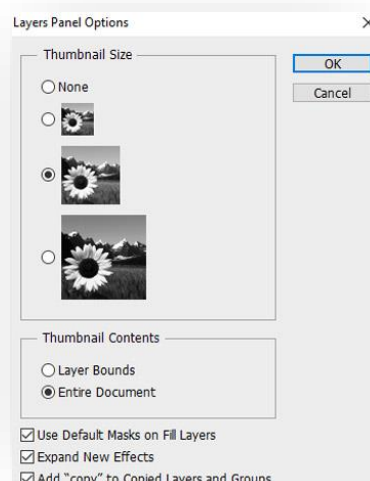
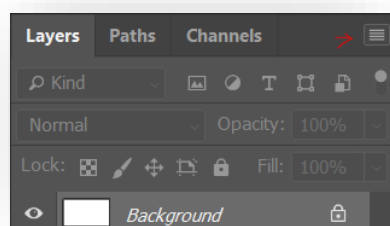
Your photo should be in RGB Color mode and 8 Bits/Channel. To check this, go to **Image > Mode**.



Your photo should be the Background layer. If it is not, go to **Layer > New > Background from Layer**.



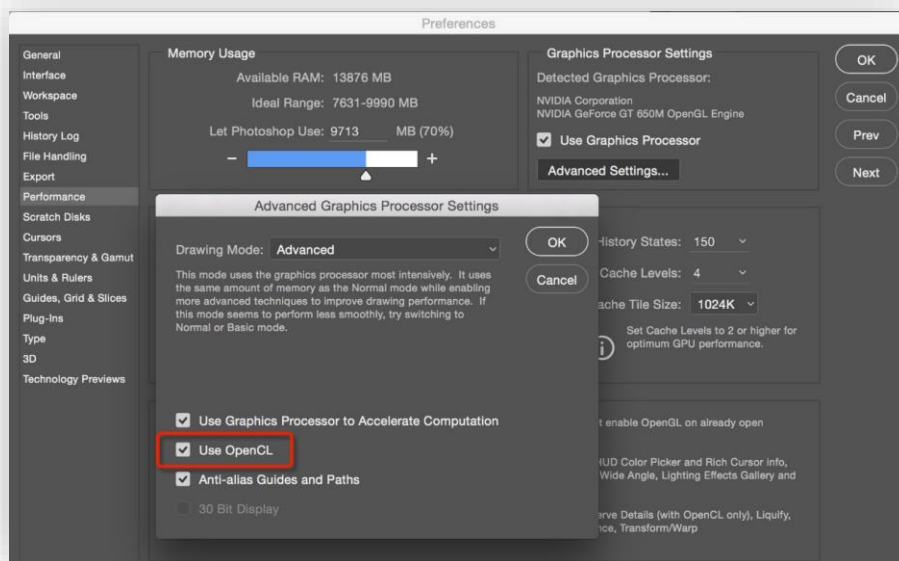
Click the **fly-out** list of the Layers panel and click **Panel Options...** Make sure Add "copy" to Copied Layers and Groups is checked.



Oil Paint Filter Problem:

Oil Paint Filter was introduced in Photoshop CS6. So, make sure you are using CS6, CC2015.5, CC2017 and above version. Some action files use oil paint filter, if you are using an action with oil paint filter then check these instructions.

Firstly check this setting and see below screen shot and make sure Use Graphics Processor is checked under Preferences > Performance for more detail check this video.
