



Installation Guide Lightroom Presets

Thank you for purchasing our presets! We are happy to be part of your creative process and have developed our presets to enable you to easily achieve beautiful edits on your own photos and even act as a starting point to inspire your creative style. Please note that our Lightroom Presets have been created to match many types of photos, therefore every preset will need slight adjustments in Exposure to adjust brightness or darkness in your photo. Mobile Presets Installation:

1. Download the Lightroom App. Tipp: To avoid setting up an Adobe Account, simply log in with your Facebook or Google account. Next, you will have to download the presets to your phone. Keep in mind, the .DNG preset files will appear as blank photos in your camera roll, this is normal. Make sure to download all presets.
2. Next, open your Lightroom App and import the preset .DNG files to your lightroom app by clicking the blue + File symbol on the lower right. Follow these steps for every preset image one by one: Open the preset photo in your lightroom gallery. Now click the 3 dots on the top right corner and select "Create Preset". Under "Preset Name" type the name of the specific preset that f.e. "Vanilla Cream 1" or "Vanilla Cream 2" and press save on the top right. Repeat for every preset.
3. CONGRATS! Now that you have uploaded all of the presets to your Lightroom App. Open a photo you would like to edit and scroll across the bottom adjustments bar until you see "Presets". Click presets and then select your presets under "User Presets", here you will see all your new presets. To make your edit perfect, make small adjustments to "Exposure" under the Lights Section by moving the slider bar.

Desktop Installation

1. Open your Lightroom Desktop Version
(Subscriptions from Adobe are available for approx. 10 USD per month)
2. Go to your downloaded presets folder and then save the .DNG files on your Computer.
3. Import the .DNG preset files the same way you would import photos to your library.
4. Once imported, go through every Image one by one, repeating the following steps:
 - Open Preset Photo
 - Go to "Develop" in the upper Bar -> New Preset
 - Name your preset accordingly f.e. "Vanilla Cream 1" or "Vanilla Cream 2" -> under section Folder select "User Presets" -> tick all boxes below in the settings section
 - Click "Create"
5. Find your newly created presets in Lightroom's "Develop" Mode on the left side bar under "Presets / User Presets"
6. To apply a preset, simply click on it.
7. To make your edit perfect and adjust it to your personal taste, play around with the sliders on the right side bar. Start with "Exposure" and "Highlights" to set Brightness Levels. Every image edit with a preset will need some small adjustments in these two areas as every photo is different.
