

How to Import Mobile Presets in Lightroom Mobile

Download the DNG files on your mobile.

Now open up Lightroom Mobile on your mobile device and add any photos that you wish to edit if you have not already done so.

Once you have added photos for editing, you need to import the presets into Lightroom Mobile. You can simply import them as usual. Like you would import other images or, create an album for the presets by clicking on the "+" next to "**Albums**" and name it "**Travel Blogger Presets.**"

Now, import the downloaded DNG files into this folder by tapping on the three dots (...) next to "**Travel Blogger Presets**" and these are the presets you will be using to apply to your images in Lightroom mobile.

How to Apply Presets to Images in Lightroom Mobile

Now that you have imported the presets into Lightroom Mobile, here is how to apply the presets to your images in Lightroom Mobile.

Open the preset that you wish to use, in your case the relevant DNG file. Tap the three dots (...) top right.

Select "**Copy Settings**" Tap "**OK**"

Go back now by tapping on the left arrow (<) top left, and choose the image that you wish to edit. Tap on the three dots (...) top right and tap "**Paste Settings**"

You have now applied the preset to your image. Long press and release to see the **Before and After**. Make changes to your image in Lightroom mobile if required.
