Mobile

1. INSTALL THE LIGHTROOM APP

Make sure you have downloaded Adobe Lightroom CC on your phone. Remember, it's free but you still need to register.



The app looks like this:





2. DOWNOALD THE PRESETS (the dng files)

You can download it directly to your phone or you can do it on your laptop as well. If you download on your laptop you can either send them yo your phone via Airdrop, Google Drive, iCloud Drive, DropBox, or via email.

After you downloaded the presets go to your downloads folder in the files app and unzip the file. Use the free app "ZIP & RAR File Extractor"(iPhone) or "gbox" (Android). Open the presets folder select the presets that you want to instal and press share.




Press "Open in Lightroom"




3. SAVE THE PRESETS

Once it's opened in Lightroom mobile, click the ellepsis on the top right and select "Create Preset". Slect the options, so you see a ble mark in some of them as shown below.

Give a name to the preset (you can use ours or be creative and choose one you like) and click in the mark symbol on the right top of the screen. You can delete the image and repeat the process again.



Now you are ready to edit your photos! Upload a picture you want to edit, press "Presets" and you can find the presets you saved under "user presets"



Macbook

- 1.** Please download and unzip the presets file and open the resulting folder.
- 2.** In this folder you will find the presets files with the XMP extension.
- 3.** Open Lightroom.
- 4.** Choose lightroom > preferences.
- 5.** There will be a new window that appears. There will be several tabs at the top of the new window. Select the presets tab.
- 6.** Click on the button labeled "show Lightroom presets folder".
- 7.** Copy downloaded folder with your presets into the develop presets folder. It is recommended that you copy the preset folder to this new location rather than moving it.
- 8.** Simply restart Lightroom and that's it. Your presets now be found in the presets section of the develop module of lightroom.

Windows

- 1.** Please download and unzip the presets file and open the resulting folder.
- 2.** In this folder you will find the presets files with the .xmo extension.
- 3.** Open lightroom.
- 4.** Choose edit>preferences.
- 5.** On the preferences window, please choose the presets tab.
- 6.** Click on the button labeled show lightroom presets folder (note: if you do not see the app data folder go to the control panel. Select folder options, click on the control panel. Select folder options, click on the view tab. You will see an option says "show hidden files and folders". Turn this option on when click ok.
- 7.** There will be a new explorer window that appears. Choose the folder named develop presets. Copy the downloaded folder with your presets into the develop presets folder. It is recommended that you copy the preset folder to this new location rather than moving it.
- 8.** Simply restart lightroom and that's it. Your presets can now be found in the presets section of the develop module of lightroom.
