Lightroom Old Versions Installation Instructions

Step 1:

In Lightroom, press **D** to open the Edit panel.

Step 2:

In the menu at the top, click on **Edit**, then on **Preferences**.

Step 3:

Go to the **Presets** tab, and click on the **Show Lightroom Presets Folder**.

Step 4:

Go to the **Lightroom** folder, then to the **Develop Presets** folder.

Step 5:

Paste the **Watercolor** folder which is in the **LRTEMPLATE** folder that you had downloaded.

Step 6:

Restart Lightroom and choose presets.

Lightroom CC Installation Instructions

Step 1:

In Lightroom CC, press **E** to open the Edit panel.

Step 2:

At the bottom right of the panel select **Presets**.

Step 3:

At the top of the presets panel click on the icon of the three **Small Dots**.

Step 4:

Navigate to the folder where you've extrated the files. Select the **.XMP** files then click OK.

Step 5:

Expand the **Watercolor** folder and select a preset.

Lightroom Classic CC Installation Instructions

Step 1:

In Lightroom Classic CC, press **D** to open the Develop panel.

Step 2:

At the bottom left of the panel in the **Presets** section, click on the add icon and choose **Import Presets**.

Step 3:

Navigate to the folder where you've extrated the files. Select the **.XMP** files then click OK.

Step 4:

Expand the **Watercolor** folder and select a preset.

Lightroom Mobile Installation Instructions

If you have a Creative Cloud subscription, all of your profiles will automatically sync to your mobile.

Step 1:

Download the product on your phone. Open the .zip file and extract the **Lightroom Mobile** folder.

Step 2:

Open the Lightroom app.

Step 3:

Click on the album then click on the **Add Photos** button. Sort it by Time, select all the DNG presets, then click Add.

Step 4:

Select a preset. Tap the menu on the top-right then tap **Copy Settings**. Go to your photo and paste the settings.
