

# HOW TO INSTALL THIS PRESET ?

---

## How do I install the presets on Lightroom for Mac?

1. Open up Lightroom
2. Click Lightroom (top left corner) > Preferences > Presets (top left part of pop up box)
3. Click Show Lightroom Presets Folder
4. Double click Lightroom folder
5. Double click Develop Presets folder
6. Drag or copy the folder with your new presets into the Develop Presets folder
7. Restart Lightroom and your new presets should be on the left once you are in the Develop tap within Lightroom

## How do I install the presets on Lightroom for Windows?

1. Open up Lightroom
2. Click Edit (top left corner) > Preferences > Presets
3. Click Show Lightroom Presets Folder
4. Double click Lightroom folder
5. Double click Develop Presets folder
6. Drag or copy the folder with your new presets into the Develop Presets folder
7. Restart Lightroom and your new presets should be on the left once you are in the Develop tap within Lightroom

## How do I put the presets on Lightroom Mobile?

1. Save the DNG file into your library.
2. Or go onto your phone and open the email that is sent to you after your purchase with the mobile presets. Once you find the email, save the DNG file to your phone's photo album.
3. Go into Adobe Lightroom CC (which you have previously downloaded to your phone) and tap the plus symbol in the top right corner, then select Create Album and title it (ex. "Photoboom presets").
4. Tap the three dots next to the new album you created and select Add Photos. Then select Camera Roll and click on the DNG files that you uploaded to your phone's camera roll and tap Add Photos. You will see the images appear in the album.
5. Find the Photoboom mobile presets that you downloaded to Adobe Lightroom CC (on your phone).
6. Click on the one you want to use and then copy the setting by clicking on the three little dots in the top right corner and click Copy Settings
7. Find the picture you want to apply the preset to (the picture must be in the Adobe Lightroom CC app)
8. Once you find the picture, click on the three little dots in the top right corner and click Paste Settings

**Note: you will usually want to make minor tweaks to your photos after the preset is applied to get the colors and light exactly how you like them! :)**

## You can also create a preset to use it without copy and paste.

1. Click on the DNG image that you already uploaded onto your phone (steps 1 to 5)
2. Click on the three little dots in the top right corner and click Create Preset
3. Give a name to your preset and choose the group you want to save it. Select all the settings and press the tick button on the top left corner.
4. When you editing a photo, go to the Presets section. You'll find it along the bottom of the screen but may have to scroll all the way to the right to find the option.

**NOTE: If you have a paid subscription to Adobe Creative Cloud then all of your presets will automatically sync from desktop to your mobile app**
