



## HOW TO USE LIGHTROOM PRESETS

1.DOWNLOAD AND UNZIP THE ZIP FILE AND OPEN THE RESULTING FOLDER

### I : FOR MOBILE LIGHTROOM

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR LIGHTROOM MOBILE (FOR THOSE USERS WHO HAVE A MOBILE LIGHTROOM VERSION ONLY)

1. YOU HAVE TO UNPACK AN ARCHIVE FIRST. YOU'LL SEE \*.XMP AND \*.DNG FILES.
2. FIRST TRANSFER DNG IMAGE FILE TO YOUR MOBILE DEVICE. FOR EXAMPLE, SEND IT TO YOUR MAIL AND SAVE IT IN YOUR PHONE'S PHOTO GALLERY OR USE YOUR CLOUD TO SYNCHRONIZE FILE WITH YOUR GALLERY.
3. OPEN THIS DNG IMAGE WITH LIGHTROOM MOBILE (ANY OTHER VIEWER PROGRAM WILL WRITE THAT IT CAN NOT OPEN THE FILE, DO NOT BE SCARED OF THIS). SELECT THIS DNG IMAGE THAT REPRESENTS THE PRESET YOU'D LIKE TO APPLY TO A FUTURE IMAGE, AND YOU SHOULD SEE THAT IMAGE, WITH THE PRESET APPLIED, IN FULL SCREEN ON YOUR DEVICE.
4. NOW TOUCH THE "... " IN THE UPPER RIGHT CORNER AND SELECT "COPY SETTINGS". THIS WILL COPY THE PRESET SETTINGS TO BE USED ON FUTURE IMAGES.
5. WHEN YOU'VE GOT THE SETTINGS COPIED, HEAD ON BACK TO THE MAIN SCREEN OF LIGHTROOM MOBILE, AND LOCATE THE IMAGE YOU'D LIKE TO EDIT. SELECT THE IMAGE TO HAVE IT FILL THE SCREEN.
6. WITH THE IMAGE SELECTED, YOU HAVE TO TOUCH THE "... " ONCE MORE, SELECT "PASTE SETTINGS". THIS SHOULD "APPLY" THE PRESET TO YOUR IMAGE, AND COMPLETE THE PROCESS OF APPLYING A PRETTY PRESET TO AN IMAGE IN LIGHTROOM MOBILE.

### 2 : FOR DESKTOP LIGHTROOM

- 1 OPEN LIGHTROOM
- 2 IN TOP MENU BAR CHOOSE LIGHTROOM>PREFERENCES.
- 3 A WINDOW APPEARS, SELECT THE PRESETS TAB.
- 4 CLICK ON SHOW LIGHTROM PRESETS FOLDER
- 4 IN THS NEW EXPLORER WINDOW OPEN THE LIGHTOOM FOLDER AND OPEN THE DEVELOP PRESETS FOLDER,
- 5 COPY AND PASTE THE PRESETS FOLDER INTO THAT LOCATION
- 6 RESTART LIGHTROM, THE ORESETS MUST BE FOUND IN THE PRESETS SECTION ON LEFT IN DEVELOP MODULE.
- 7 OPEN YOUR IMAGEAND CLICK ON ANY PRESET TO APPLY IT.
