

HOW TO INSTALL:

Extract the files to a folder, then **double-click** the **ATN**, **ABR**, **GRD** and **PAT** files to install them in Photoshop.

You can also use the following panels to install the files in your Photoshop:

Window > Actions

Window > Patterns

Window > Brushes

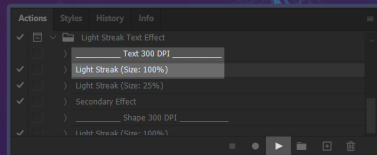
Window > Gradients

After installed, you will only interact with the **Actions** and **Gradient** Panels, so don't worry about the other panels.

HOW TO RUN THE ACTION:

Make sure your document is **300 dpi** and will fit the text with a size of **282 pt**

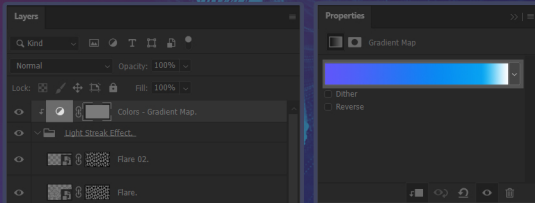
Write your text and choose your font, then go to the **Actions** panel and **click** on **Light Streak (Size 100%)**. After that **click** on the **Play** icon.



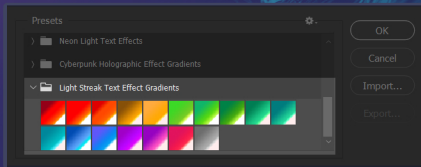
Both 100% and 25% sizes requires the same document size and resolution.

HOW TO EDIT:

After you run the action, you will want to choose the colors. To do that, **double-click** on the icon of the **Colors - Gradient Map** layer, then **click** on the **gradient bar**.



The **Gradient Editor** will open. Now go to the **Light Streak Text Effects Gradients** and choose one that you like.



Note that some **layers** in the **Light Streak Effect** folder have a mask, don't forget that you can use that to hide or show some parts of the effects.

To activate the alternative result version of the action, all you have to do is to enable the **Base** layer.

The secondary effect is a simple text effect that looks good with an interlaced effect. Check the video tutorial if you wanna learn how to do that.
