# .lrtemplate and .xmp instructions

Install → **.lrtemplate files** if you have Lightroom before 7.3 update

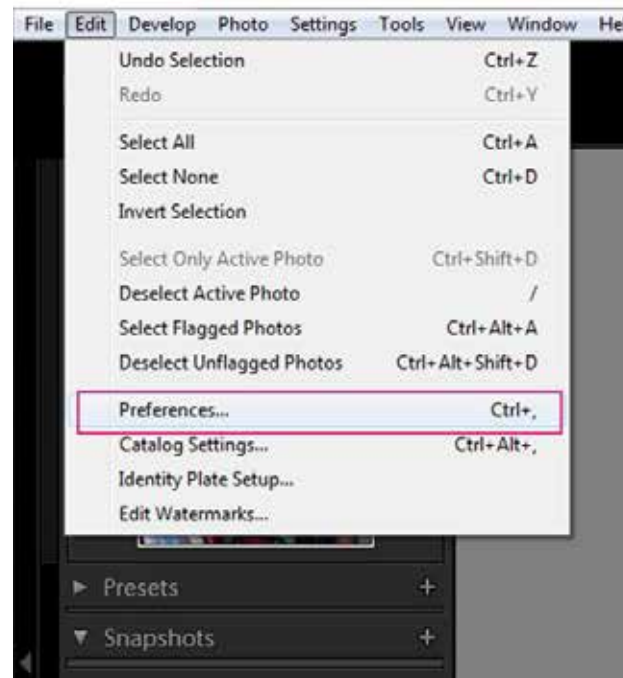
Install → **.xmp files** if you have Lightroom 7.3 and above (mid. 2018 update)

## How to Install your Lightroom Presets (the .lrtemplate files):

### On a PC

1.  
**On a PC**, go into Lightroom and click on **Edit** at the top (next to File), then click on **Preferences**.

**On a Mac**, click on the **Lightroom tab** (to the left of File), then click on **Preferences**.

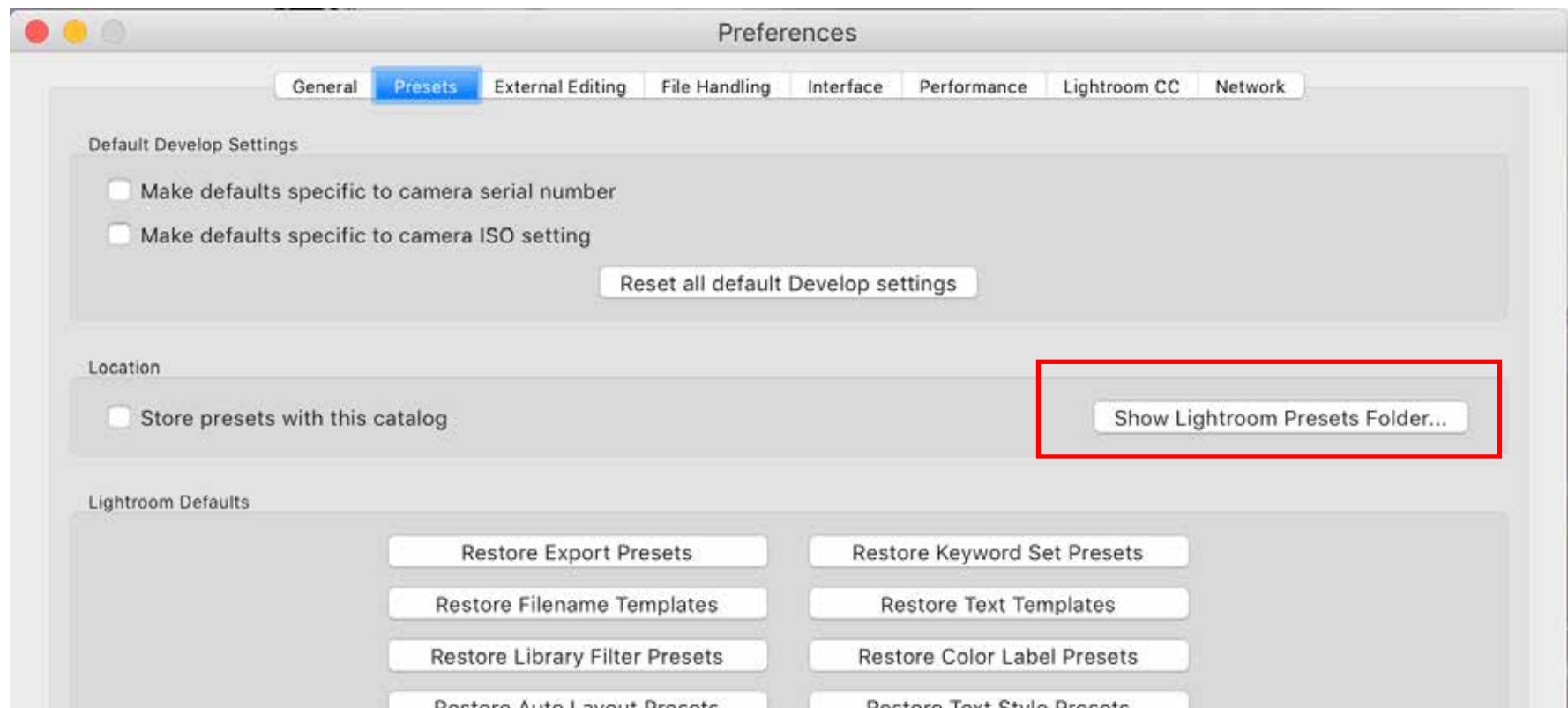

There will be a new screen that pulls up and there will be several tabs at the top, click on Presets (the second tab).

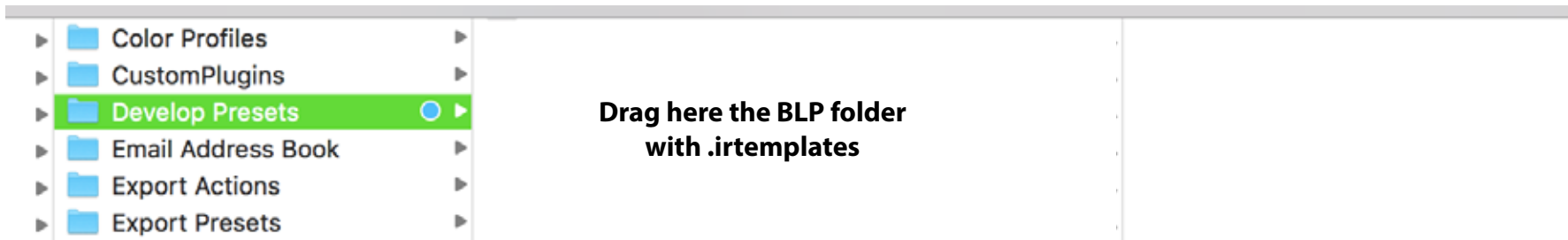
**Old lightroom before version 7.3** will show you this panel. **You need to use .irtemplate**

3. Click on the box titled, **Show Lightroom Presets Folder...**

5. Copy the “**BLP - name of the preset**” you have unzipped that contains .Irrtemplate files into the “**Develop Presets**” folder.



6. Quit Lightroom and open again. **You're done!**

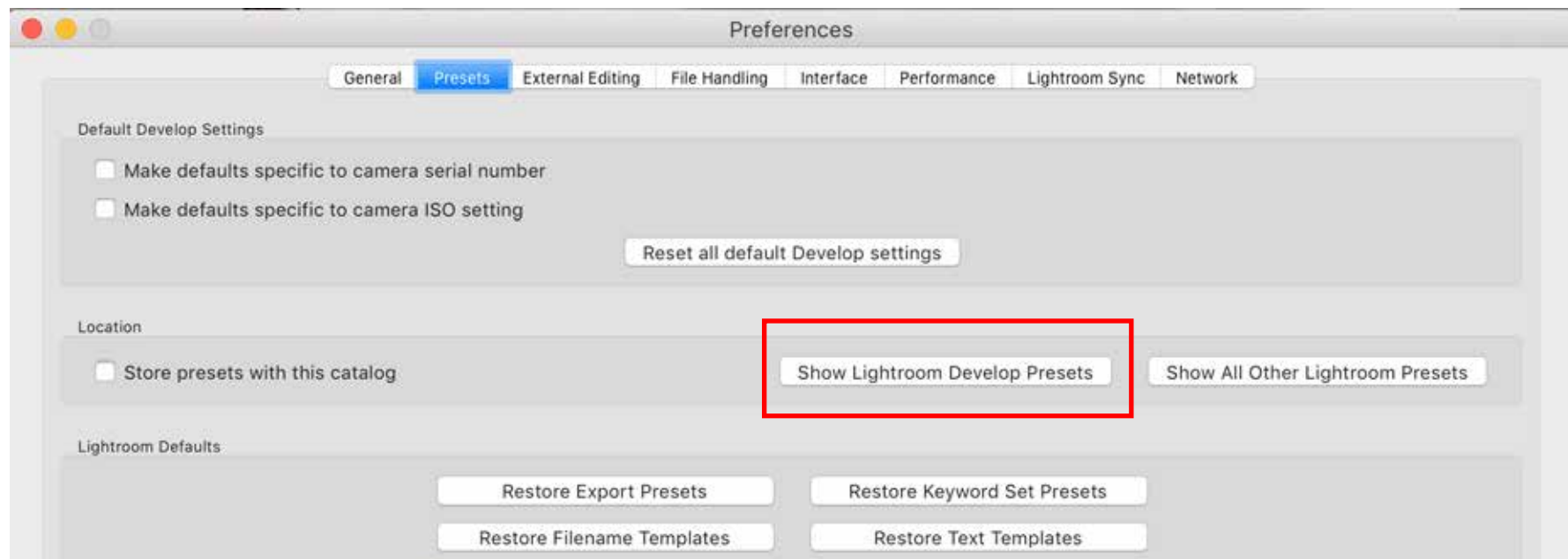

## How to Install your Lightroom Presets (the .xmp files):

**New Lightroom 7.3 and above** will show you this panel. **You need to use .xmp**

**3.** Click on the box titled, **Show Lightroom Develop Presets**

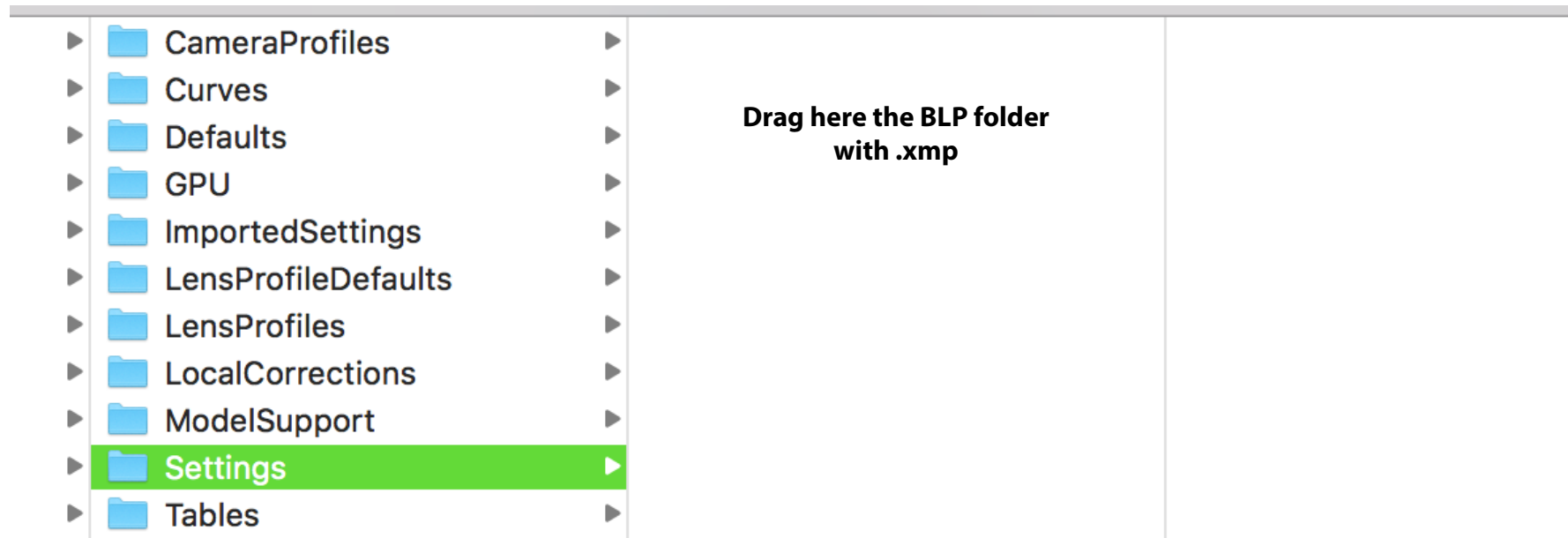
**TIP:** You can import older .irtemplate also in the newer Lightroom CC click on the **Show All Other Lightroom Presets** button. Note that Lightroom will convert the old presets to the newest .xmp format.

5. Copy the “**BLP - name of the preset**” you have unzipped that contains .xmp files into the “**Settings**” folder.

**TIP:** The **Settings** folder is shared with Photoshop, so if you have Photohsop too you can access the presets also from the Adobe Camera Raw (ACR) panel in Adobe Photoshop!



6. Quit Lightroom and open again. **You're done!**
