## Using This Design...

### ***How to install custom fonts***

- Sparrowworks creations often use custom fonts to create unique looking designs so that your product stands out from the rest. In order to edit the text in our templates you will often need to download these fonts and install them on your computer. Don't worry! It is very simple!

For Windows 10 users:

1. First, close any open applications. Newly installed fonts may not appear in your font menu if you ignore this step.
2. Unzip the folder containing the fonts first. Fonts cannot be installed if they are zipped.
3. Right click on the font file and select Install.

**OR**

1. Search for **Fonts** in the search box by the start menu or find it at "C:\Windows\Fonts"
2. Click on the Fonts (Control Panel) link to open the Fonts Manager
3. Drag and Drop or Copy and Paste the unzipped fonts into the Fonts Manager to install.

For Mac users:

Install using Font Book:

1. First, close any open applications. Newly installed fonts may not appear in your font menu if you ignore this step.
2. Double click the unzipped font file and Font Book will open a preview of the font.
3. Click "Install Font" at the bottom of the preview.


Manually install:

1. First, close any open applications. Newly installed fonts may not appear in your font menu if you ignore this step.
2. Open Finder and click the Go menu at the top of the screen.
3. While in the Go menu, hold down both the Alt/Option and Shift keys on your keyboard to reveal the hidden link to the Library folder
4. Navigate to your Fonts folder: /Users/**Your\_Username**/Library/Fonts
5. Drag and drop the unzipped font files into this folder.

### **-Using Smart Objects-**

Some of our creations use Smart Objects which you can edit and change out for your own photos. To change and/or edit them you simply:

1. Look for the smart object in the layers. *(See example of a "linked" Smart Object below)*



2. Right click on the Smart Object and select **"Edit Contents."**
3. A new image will open. You may now edit this new image to whatever you would like in that placeholder.
4. When you are done, simply press **"Ctrl+S"** to save or go to file and select save to save the image. Your new image will now be in the artwork.
5. You can find all of the related Smart Objects in the properly marked folder in your zip file labeled **"Smart Objects"**
