

## In this action convert your image to HDR Pro Photoshop Actions

This action has been tested and works photoshop CS6, CC, CC 2015, CC 2015.5, CC 2017, CC 2018, CC 2019, CC 2020 + version.

### INSTRUCTIONS

1. Your Photoshop document must be in RGB colour mode. To check this, go to the menu **Image -> Mode -> RGB Colour** check the right screenshot. Check in Figure 1.
2. Your Photoshop document must be setup in **8bits/Channel**. To check this, to the menu **Image -> Mode -> 8bits/Channel** check the right screenshot. Check in Figure 1.
3. Check layer Panel Option all 3-check boxes checked. Check in Figure 2
4. No need to initial layer naming.
5. Your main image should be set as a background. If your image have a difference name like as layer 0, select it and then go to : Layer->New->Background from layer.
6. If you have done everything and still getting errors, please reset your preference files. **Edit > Preferences > General** and then selecting **Reset** Preferences then restart photoshop.

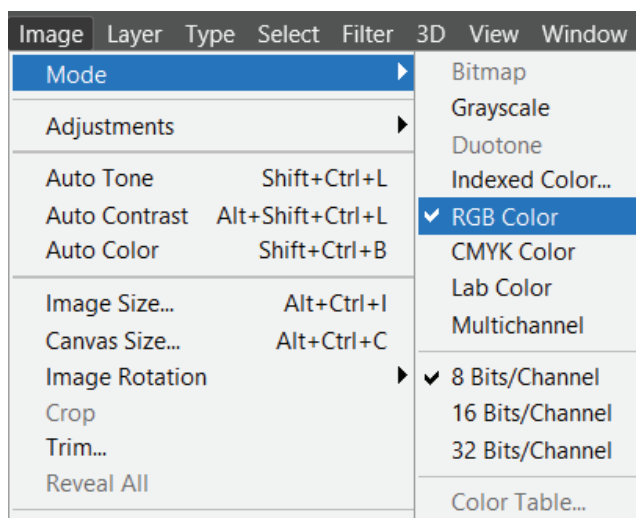

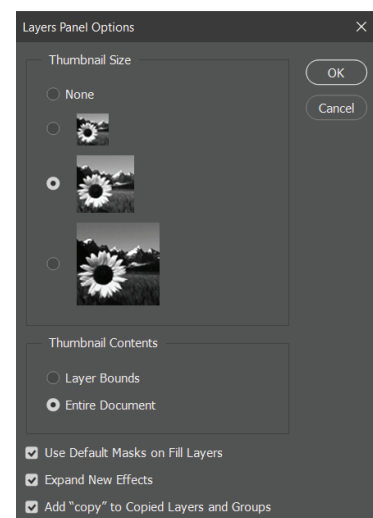

## HOW TO INSTALL THE ACTION :

1. Open your photo.
2. Load the " 47 HDR Pro .atn " file.  
  
    > go to window > Actions.  
    on the Action panel , click on the top right icon to drop down the menu.  
    from the menu select " Load Actions " and browse to the  
    " 47 HDR Pro .atn " file.
3. Go to action palette, open the actions folder, select the action you want to run.
4. Customize your final artwork.

## HOW TO USE ACTION:

1. Open a photo to work with
2. Resize your image to 2500px for high detailed result
3. Play the action you want in the Actions panel

### Note:

Be sure your Photoshop set to RGB color, 8Bits/Channel, English version.  
If you are not using English version then you can change it to English.
