

NOW, HERE YOU HAVE THE INSTRUCTIONS FOR DOWNLOAD:


1. Click on the download link:
<https://www.dropbox.com/sh/tah4sdq1i314qa0/AACO4aAYBKgpObhWMaSYLI-Aa?dl=0>

Click on the text that says “Or continue to website”. It will open a Dropbox folder with two folders: **Desktop** and **Mobile**, with .lrtemplate and dng files.




2. Open one of the files, on Dropbox, and click on the three dots on the top right corner and select "Direct Download". On desktop, just click the download icon.

3. Click on the file and then the download icon



4. Click on "Save Image". This will save the file on your camera roll, which might look blank (*meow, do not worry!*). Repeat this with all the other ".dng" files.

BUT HERE'S A LITTLE HELP:

MOBILE

1. Download the free Adobe Lightroom Mobile app
2. Open the Lightroom Mobile app.
3. Click on the Gallery button in the bottom right corner.
4. Select and import the .DNG files.
5. After importing the DNG files, click on one of the photos.
6. Once it opens, tap the 3 dots button in the top right corner of the screen and select 'Create Preset'.
7. Give the preset a name, eg 'FALL in love'
8. Save it to a new group by clicking on the 'Preset Group' drop-down menu. Then click 'Create New Preset Group' and give the new group a name eg 'Tsuki Presets'.
9. Click on the tick button in the top right corner to save the preset.

DESKTOP

1. Install the Lightroom CC.
2. Open Lightroom CC on Desktop
3. Select the Edit button on the right panel. Or simply press the 'E' key on your keyboard.
4. Click on 'Presets' – it's located at the bottom of the editing section.
5. Click on the three dots to the right of 'Presets' and then choose 'Import Presets'

6. Navigate to the presets folder (most likely located in your downloads folder) and go to the 'Desktop_Files' folder
7. Select all the .xmp files within this folder and then click 'Import' . Your presets are now ready to use in the 'Presets' section.
