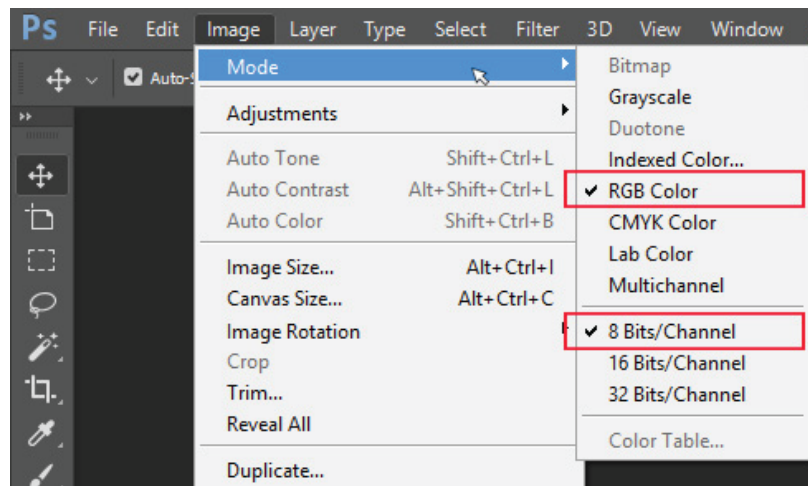

# STEP BY STEP GUIDE

## *How to SETUP*

- 1, Open your image in Photoshop
- 2, Paste your background
- 3, Set image mode to RGB color & 8 Bits/Channel.

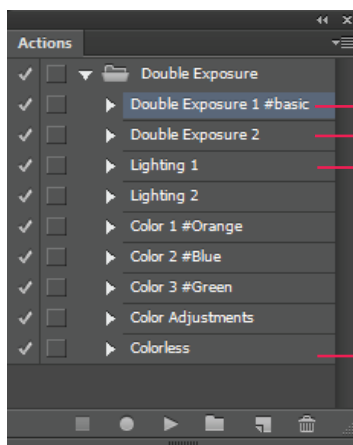


- 4, For the best results, use photos between 1500px and 6000px high/wide. Recommended image size is 3000px, resolution: 72 - 300dpi
- 5, Load action (window > action > load action > choose action file "Double Exposure Action" from downloaded zip file > load)
- 5, Play action, Done.

## How to *PLAY ACTION*

Open Action panel by going to **Window > Actions**.

Now select the **Double Exposure 1 #basic** and click **Play**.

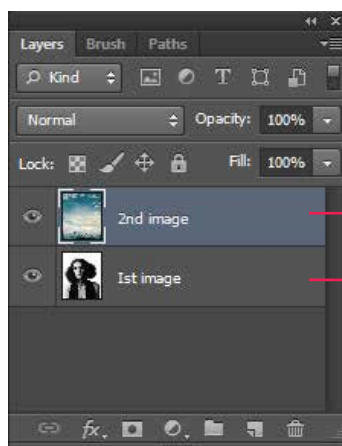


“Double Exposure 1 #basic”, default action.

“Double Exposure 2” is an extra action  
Try each action and have fun.
