

# STEP BY STEP GUIDE

## *How to SETUP*

- 1, Open your image in Photoshop
- 2, Set image mode to **RGB color** & **8 Bits/Channel**.



- 4, For the best results , use photos between 2000px and 5000 px high/wide. Recommended image size is 3000px.

- 3, Select brush tool, On the top tool bar, make sure **Mode** is Normal, and both **opacity** and **flow** values are set to **100%**



## How to *INSTALL*

5, Install Action file.


- a) Inside Photoshop, go to the File > Open...
- b) Inside the Open window, navigate to the **Magico light** folder which you downloaded.
- c) Navigate inside the **ACTION** folder
- d) If you are using Photoshop CC versions select following file -  
“**Magico Light Photoshop Action CC.atn**”  
from **Photoshop CC** folder.

If you are using Photoshop CS5 or CS6 version select following file -  
“**Magico Light Photoshop Action.atn**”  
from **Photoshop CS5, CS6** folder.

- e) Click **Open** to load files in **Photoshop**.

6, Install Brush files and Pattern files.

- a) Inside Photoshop, go to the File > Open...
- b) Inside the Open window, navigate to the **Magico light** folder which you downloaded.
- d) Select following files - “**Magico light Brushes.abr**” and  
“**Magico Light Patterns.pat**”
- e) Click **Open** to load files in **Photoshop**.



## ***BRUSH Subject Area***


7, Create a new layer and brush subject area with any color



## ***How to PLAY ACTION***

7, Open Action panel by going to **Window > Actions**.

Now select the **Magico light action** and click **Play**.
