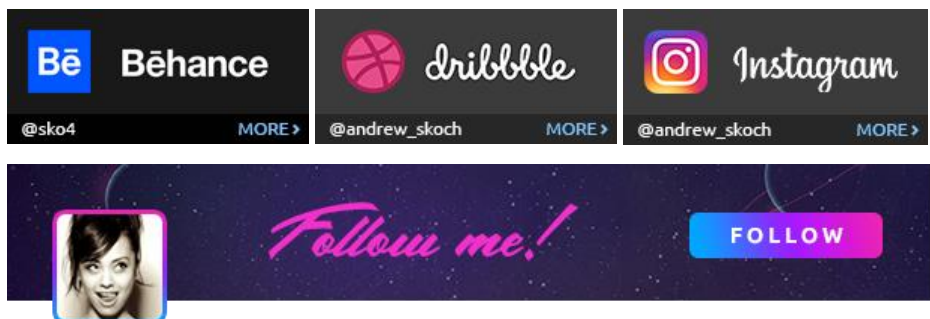

## It's very easy to use this action:

### 1. Install action into your Photoshop:



Simply double-click (or drag and drop into your Photoshop) file **Spray Paint [by Sko4].atn**

### 2. Install Brushes into your Photoshop:



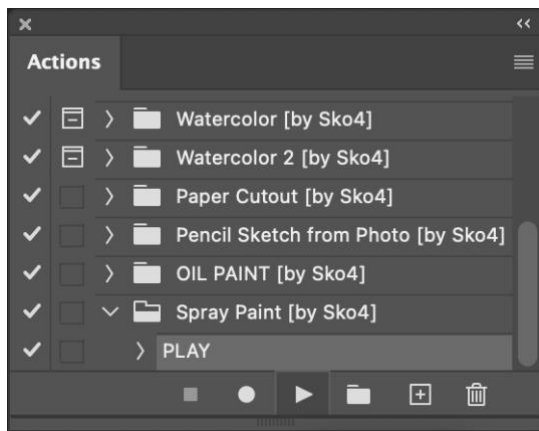
Simply double-click (or drag and drop into your Photoshop) file **Spray Brushes [by Sko4].abr**

### 3. Create new .PSD file or open existing project. Choose layer or layer group (Layers can be called by any names.)

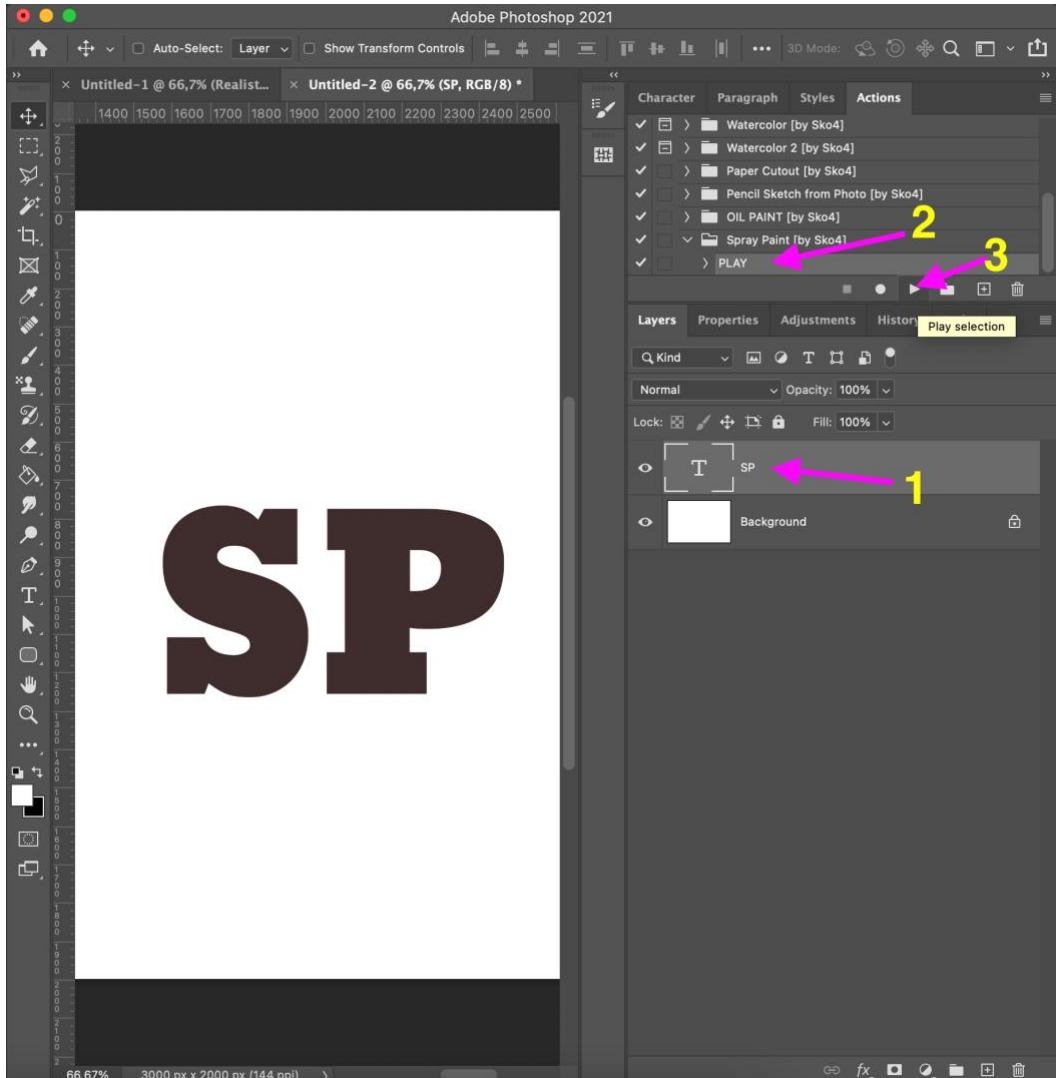
### 4. Go to the actions palette

If the actions palette is not visible, go to “Window”, then click “Actions” in the dropdown

Find in Actions palette **Spray Paint [by Sko4]**

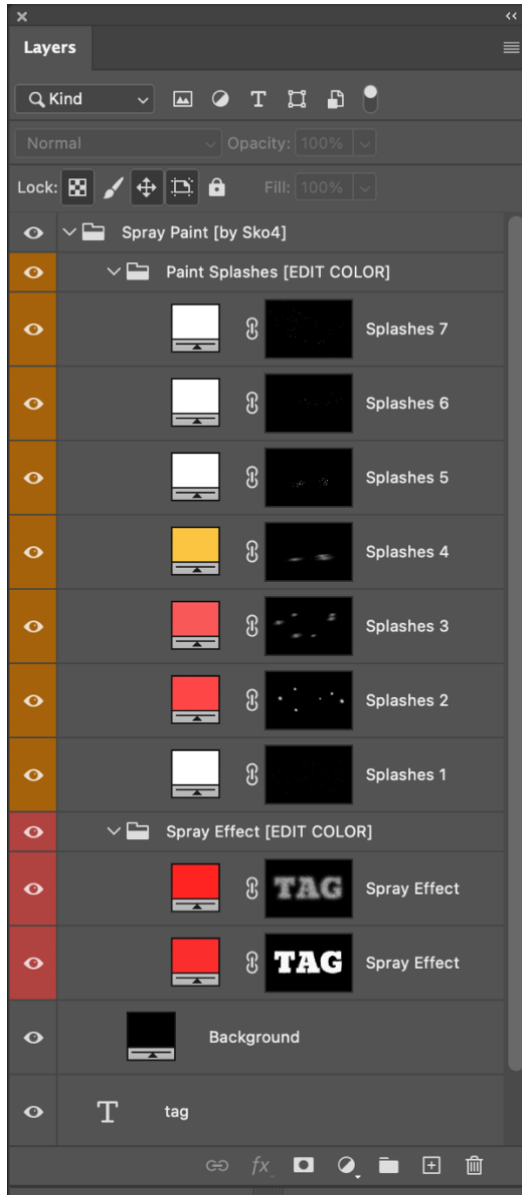


With needed layer selected click the 'Play' button and wait for the action to complete.



You can use action multiple times to get different results!  
You can play action in the same .PSD file multiple times.

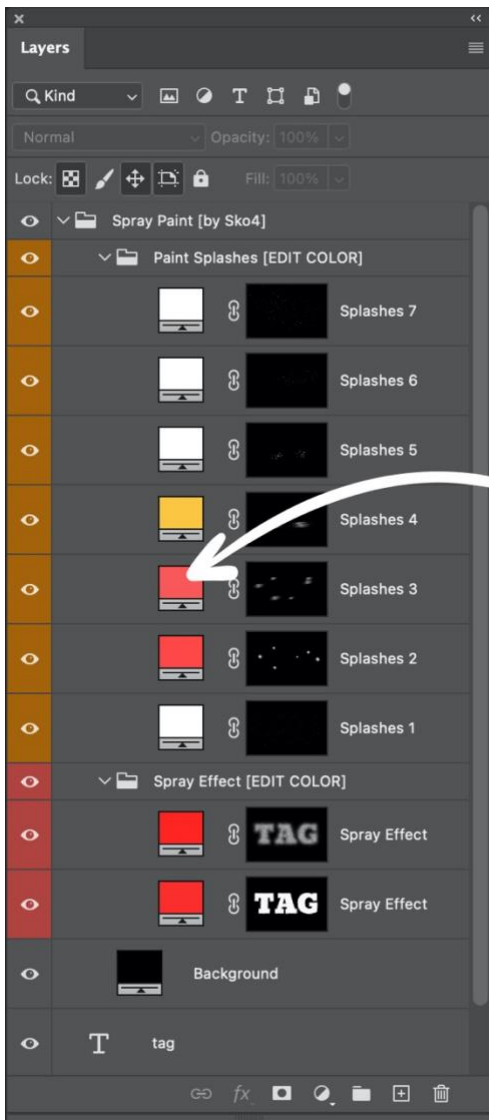
## 5. Customize results



There are 7 layers with paint drops and splashes. You can edit color of each layer.

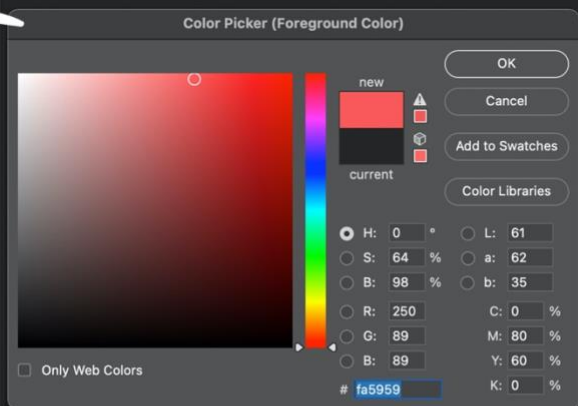
Double click on layer thumbnail (colored square)

And choose new color.
