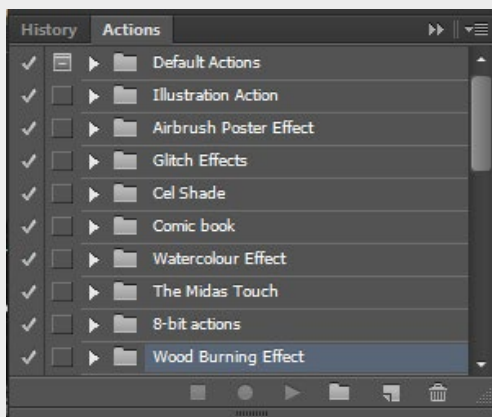

Step 1 - Installing Your Actions

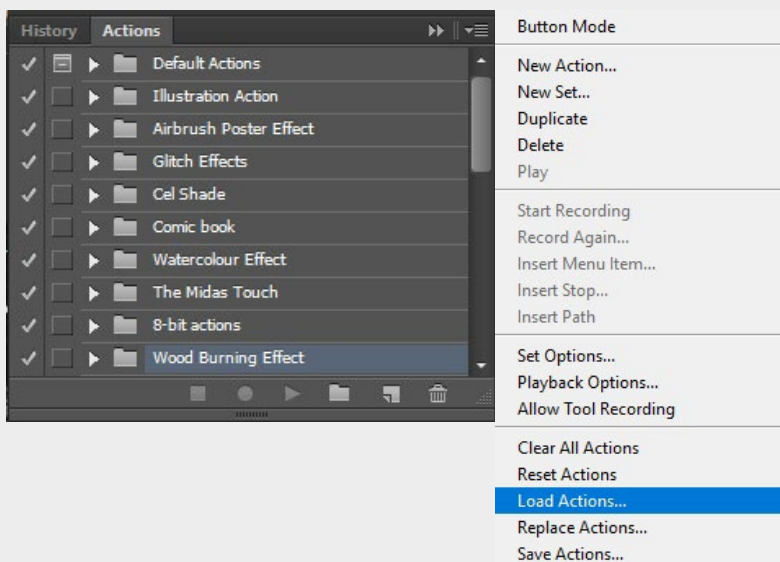
After you've downloaded the ZIP file containing your actions, you'll need to unpack the contents of the file.

This should reveal a new folder containing the .ATN file for your new actions.

After you've found the .atn file, double-click it. In Photoshop, open up your Actions panel (Window > Actions).



If you don't see the actions, you can load it manually by clicking on the panel menu and selecting Load Actions



That's it! Once your actions are loaded in Photoshop, you're ready to go. Just click play on the action to see some great results.

- ▶ You must open the image you want to convert as a new document. It will not work if you drag or paste the image onto your canvas. It must be opened as a new document by going to File > Open and then selecting the desired image.

This Photoshop action works best with images at the standard size of 1920x1280 pixels.
